The project includes the construction of 29 km length underground railway infrastructure as integrated system of 20 stations, 1 courtyards — workshops; and operation of 47 trains (composed of 7 cars each one), in order to benefit a population estimated at 700 thousand inhabitants.





INTERNATIONAL NORTH HIGHWAY: SULLANA - PTE INTERNACIONAL LA PAZ

Objective: Improve the standard of the "North Panamericana Highway" from Sullana to the border with Ecuador, transforming this highway into a modern, comfortable and safe one. The project proposes 277 km to road adjustment works, 63 km of road improvement, construction of 5 express lane with double roadway and single roadway (Sullana, Los Órganos, Cancas and Zorritos); and construction of 100 km of a second roadway parallel to that existing at different points. Total extension of the project: 276.9 km.
